Dear Troop 94 Parents and Scouts,

Summer Camp/Sea Base: Summer Camp is just 4 weeks away! Here is your checklist:

- **Payment:** All payments were due on May 17. If you have not paid in full yet, contact Mr. S. ASAP or you will lose your spot! Payment for merit badge/activity fees will be due on June 28 at the court of honor.
- **Medical Forms:** **All** participants (youth and adult) **MUST** have a completed BSA medical form and physical within the last 12 months preceding camp. The new BSA medical form is available on the website or in the scout room. Old forms are no longer usable.
- **Gear:** Check the troop website for the Summer Camp packing list. A new troop T-shirt and neckerchief will be provided to all participants before we leave. Remember to pack your overnight bag for Saturday night (including full Class A uniform). Note: **all** first-year campers need to bring a pair of long pants and a long-sleeved shirt for swimming class.

- Schedule: Mr. S. has your camp schedule available. Check that everything is correct and get any changes to him ASAP. Note: first-year campers will not have any twilight activities on Thursday; their group is going on an overnight campout that night.
- Get ready to have fun! We will depart from Asbury on Saturday, July 3 at 8:00am sharp! Be there early ready to load your gear and turn in your medical form. It is extremely important that you communicate with Mr. S. if you will be delayed; otherwise you may miss your ride to camp!

Troop/Patrol Elections: Troop and Patrol elections will be on Monday, May 14. Scouts of rank First Class and higher are especially encouraged to run for Troop positions or Patrol Leader.

Board of Review: A Board of Review for rank advancement for Tenderfoot and above will be held during the May 21 meeting. If you are eligible for review, you must meet with Mr. S. in advance so he can conduct a scoutmaster conference and schedule your review.

Troop Court of Honor, June 28: Court of Honor will be Monday, June 28 at 7:00. All families are invited. Advancement and awards earned since November will be recognized, and the new patrol leader council will be installed. All families are asked to bring a plate of snacks to share. The troop will provide drinks.
